Contests

Battle of the Buckets, Bucket Brigade, Tug of War, EMS Contest, Fastest Dressed Obstacle Course

Registration

Registration for contests will be held at the Newburg Volunteer Rescue Squad & Fire Department. Departments can complete registration forms in advance and submit them via email with the rest of the info or bring the forms with them and turn it in with the packet at registration for the parade. Only one representative (captain) from a department is needed to register the team. The team captain will have to sign the rules and regulations for contests indicating they have read and agree to the rules and regulations.

General Contest Rules

- 1) Unsportsmanlike conduct, including foul or abusive language will not be tolerated. Failure to abide by this rule may result in disqualification.
- 2) **ANY** fighting during a contest will result in the disqualification of both teams.
- 3) Failure to comply with contest rules will be grounds for automatic disqualification. No contest judge will come from a participating department.
- 4) Each team must have a designated team captain, who is responsible for having their team ready at the start of each contest. Team captains are also responsible for signing for rules explanation, and explaining rules to team members.
- 5) Due to time constraints, departments may be limited in the number of teams they can register for individual contests. If this affects a contest, it will be identified in the individual contest rules.
